## NEWS RELEASE September 21, 2011

At approximately 0200 Hours this date, Marquette Police responded to the 1000 block of W. Ridge Street in the City of Marquette for a shooting incident. Upon arrival officers found a 49 year old male Marquette resident deceased from an apparent gunshot wound. Officers also discovered another shooting victim, a 23 year old female Marquette resident, who was suffering from and obvious gunshot wound to her leg. The female victim was taken to MGH for treatment of her injuries.

During the investigation a 22 year old male Marquette resident, a person of interest, was developed. Through interviews and searching, that person was found hiding in a vehicle a short distance from the scene and taken into custody. Officers are still investigating the incident. More information will be made available later in the day.

## UPDATE NEWS RELEASE September 21, 2011

The subjects involved in the early morning shooting incident in the 1000 block of W. Ridge Street have been identified by the Marquette Police. John Adam Bradbury, 49 of Marquette was the individual who was found deceased at the scene by the responding Police. Upon further investigation, Rayan Zimmerman, a female from Marquette, was found to have suffered a gunshot wound to the leg. The female subject was taken to MGH for her injuries

Further investigation into the matter turned up a suspect identified as Tyler John Wolf. Officers, through interviews and searching, found Wolf hiding in a car across the street in a parking lot. Wolf was taken into custody without incident and was lodged for the charges of Open Murder and on a parole detainer.
